About the Service

Welcome to Eventide at St. James's. At this service, we explore a type of worship that theologian Robert Webber has described as "Ancient-Future," using prayers and a liturgy that are rooted in the deep traditions of the Church while also being open to more modern forms of music and worship. Speaking of Ancient-Future worship, Webber said, "The way into the future... is not an innovative new start for the church; rather, the road to the future runs through the past."¹ Through this type of Ancient-Future worship, we hope to provide a space where everyone can participate in the liturgy to the fullest extent, offering a sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving to God in body, mind, and spirit. If you're curious about specific aspects of the liturgy, we encourage you to check out the Liturgy Cheat Sheet either before or after the service, or feel free to reach out to a member of the staff, clergy, or lay leaders with questions.

By the nature of this being an evening service with more modern music, we hope you'll feel comfortable to come as you are, without feeling the pressure of getting "dressed up" for church. But of course, if you want to get dressed up, do!

Whoever you are, and whatever has brought you here, we're so thankful that you've decided to join us at St. James's today.

Directions to Restrooms: If you enter the church through the front door, you will be in the narthex. Take a right, and the restrooms are located at the bottom of the stairs.

Sermon

Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. We pray for the community: God of truth, inspire with your wisdom those whose decisions affect the lives of others **That all may act with integrity and courage.** Give grace to all whose lives are linked with ours. **May we serve Christ in one another, and love as he loves us.**

We pray for those in need: God of hope, comfort and restore all who suffer in body, mind, or spirit. **May they know the power of your healing love.** Make us willing agents of your compassion. **Strengthen us as we share in making people whole.**

I now invite your own prayers and petitions, either silently or aloud: *Particular intercessions/thanksgivings may be offered.*

Grant that we may walk in your presence: Your love in our hearts, Your truth in our minds, Your strength in our wills; Until, at the end of our journey, We know the joy of our homecoming And the welcome of your embrace, Through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

It is right indeed, it is our joy and our salvation, holy Lord, almighty Father, everlasting God, at all times and in all places to give you thanks and praise through Christ your only Son.
