

## **“Best Boardwalk Hike in Virginia.”**



R. Garland Dodds Park at Point of Rocks is a 176-acre park with a diverse natural area. The park includes trails through upland forests and an extensive boardwalk through a freshwater tidal marsh. It's a great place for birders and the plants of the tidal freshwater marshes are very interesting in the fall. The area also has historical significance, including Civil War-era earthworks. Trails will be of easy to moderate difficulty. Optional to Bring: Water and snacks; binoculars; magnifying glass. Wear comfortable shoes and dress for the weather.
