Welcome to Eventide at St. James's. At this service, we explore a type of worship that theologian Robert Webber has described as "Ancient-Future," using prayers and a liturgy that are rooted in the deep traditions of the Church while also being open to more modern forms of music and worship. Speaking of Ancient-Future worship, Webber said, "The way into the future... is not an innovative new start for the church; rather, the road to the future runs through the past."¹ Through this type of Ancient-Future worship, we hope to provide a space where everyone can participate in the liturgy to the fullest extent, offering a sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving to God in body, mind, and spirit. If you're curious about specific aspects of the liturgy, we encourage you to check out the Liturgy Cheat Sheet either before or after the service, or feel free to reach out to a member of the staff, clergy, or lay leaders with questions.

By the nature of this being an evening service with more modern music, we hope you'll feel comfortable to come as you are, without feeling the pressure of getting "dressed up" for church. But of course, if you want to get dressed up, do!

It is right indeed, it is our joy and our salvation, holy Lord, almighty Father, everlasting God, at all times and in all places to give you thanks and praise through Christ your only Son.

You are the source of all life and goodness; through your eternal Word you have created all things from the beginning and formed us in your own image.

When we sinned and turned away you called us back to yourself and gave your Son to share our human nature. By his death on the cross, he made the one perfect sacrifice for the sin of the world and freed us from the bondage of sin. You raised him to life triumphant over death; you exalted him in glory. In him you have made us a holy people by sending upon us your holy and lifegiving Spirit.

Therefore loving God, recalling your great goodness to us in Christ, his suffering and death, his resurrection and ascension, and looking for his coming in glory, we celebrate our redemption with this bread of life and this cup of salvation.
