Did you know all youth in 6th-12th grades are eligible to become an acolyte, or that over 75 youth are currently serving as acolytes here at St. James's? Becoming an acolyte is a great way to serve others and learn more about the Episcopal Church. Thank you to all our current acolytes for serving in this important ministry.

All 6th-12th graders can become an acolyte at any time!

Acolyte Ministry 101...

- All 6th-12th graders are welcome to acolyte, even those who sing in youth choir.
- To become an acolyte, you just need to contact the acolyte masters and attend an acolyte training.
- Beginning in 6th grade, you're eligible to be a torch bearer and banner bearer.
- Starting in 9th grade, you're eligible to be trained as a crucifer.
- Once trained, you'll be assigned to an acolyte team that serves in worship about 8 times throughout the school year. In the summer, individual acolytes sign up for 1-2 services when available.
- If you can't serve when scheduled, it's each acolyte's responsibility to arrange a substitute.
- All acolytes are asked to attend a training session <u>annually</u> as a refresher, and to welcome new acolytes!
