Come join 6th - 12th grade youth from St. James's and Christ Church Episcopal, Glen Allen for the Spring Youth Day of Service at Shalom Farms! **Youth can earn 2 hours of community service for participating!** Shalom Farms is a regional food access and community development project serving 1,500 individuals and families per year. The six acre farm where we'll be working will harvest 85,000 lbs. of produce for the community in 2018.

St. James's Youth Leaders will meet youth at Shalom Farms to chaperone and work with you on the farm. Great news – **there is no cost to participate!** You just have to register online. In the registration form you'll find a link to a required Shalom Farms volunteer waiver that also must be signed. Registration is due by March 18. Dress appropriately for farm work and the weather; we're outside 99% of the time. Eat a hardy breakfast before you come and bring a water bottle. The address for Shalom Farms is 2676 Venita Road, Midlothian, VA 23113. Parents are responsible for arranging transportation for their child to and from the farm.
