- Registration: All students participating in Sunday School must be registered by a parent/guardian. Registrations are accepted at any time throughout the school year. It's never too late to get involved! To register your child for Sunday School, please fill out a Sunday School Registration Form (one form per child).
- Class Time: Sunday School is from 10:15 to 11:00 a.m.
